Bermuda Captive Conference scheduled to go ahead

Here are some details:

- **HURRICANE IRMA:** Weather services confirm Irma poses no threat to Bermuda and its track is not projected to affect our island. If your flight has been cancelled and you cannot attend the conference, please contact Rhona Emmerson @ 1-441/2952626 or info@bermudacaptive.bm.
- **HURRICANE JOSÉ:** According to the US National Hurricane Center, José is about 1,000 nautical miles to our south and currently tracking to bypass the island. It is not forecast to affect Bermuda during the conference. No storm or hurricane warnings or watches for José have been issued for Bermuda, and there have been no government cancellations.
